

He received the Dr. phil. degree at the Freie Universität Berlin. A Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and Corresponding Member of the Austrian Academy of Sciences and the Academia Europaea, he was awarded a Guggenheim fellowship, a Fulbright fellowship at the Nagoya Seminar, and an honorary degree from the Universität Regensburg. He is the author of Amiri Baraka / LeRoi Jones: The Quest for a "Populist Modernism" (1978), Beyond Ethnicity (1986), Neither Black nor White yet Both (1997), Ethnic Modernism (2008), The Temptation of Despair (2014, German edition 2017), African American Writing (2016), and Challenges of Diversity (2017). He has edited more than two dozen


